Academics/Character/Career

- Our first annual Community Opportunities Fair was a great success. We had over forty
 vendors, including colleges, community organizations, military branches, and several
 employers. This was an excellent opportunity for our students and students from
 University Prep and Eugenio Maria de Hostas and open to community members. In
 addition, Channel 10 and 13 were present to interview staff and students. The story

- Our Optics students took a field trip to the Corning Museum of Glass to see examples of what they spent the semester learning about in action. The museum also has a new program called Corning's technician pipeline program (TPP). Candidates selected for the TPP receive a full scholarship covering tuition, books, and fees <u>PLUS</u> a \$30K annual salary (worth a combined \$40,000 / yr.). They complete an AAS degree in a technology field. Upon completion of the degree, they convert to a full-time technician role with Corning Incorporated. One of our fourth-year students is applying for this program with Mrs. Prabhat's (our science teacher) guidance.
- The last day of in-person school is Wednesday, the 16th. We will return to school for the summer session on July 7th. The summer session will run Monday through Thursday until August 12th.
- The baseball club participated in community service, doing a "clean sweep" of the Humboldt Street neighborhood. After all their hard work, they attended a Red Wings Game as a team. For several, it was their first time at Red Wings stadium. Although they had to forfeit their season, they stuck with the club and ended the year with a club vs. staff game this past Friday.
