Academics/Character/Career

Finance/Operations/Compliance

- We have applied for reimbursement funding from the Emergency Connectivity Fund FCC for the budgeted cost of our Chromebooks and laptops for the 2022-23 school year. This would be a total of \$64,036.40 once approved.
