Progress reports will be handed out at Family Night. (They will not be sent home)

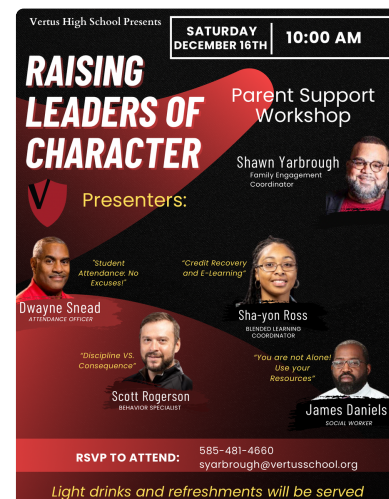
Parent Support Workshop- 12/16

Your participation in this workshop is highly encouraged, as it will undoubtedly contribute to your child's educational progress.



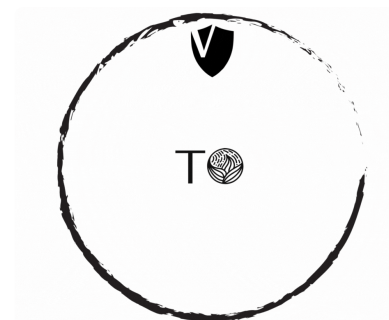
Reminders:
