### **Edgenuity Online Coursework:**

- Access and complete your assignments by logging in to Edgenuity at https://auth.edgenuity.com/Login/Login/Student.
- Monitor your completion percentage and stay aware of upcoming deadlines.

### **Preceptor/Teacher Check-In:**

• Ensure you are responsive to any communications from your Preceptor/Teachers, who are there to offer support and guidance.

#### In-Person Class Coursework:

- Fulfill any assignments provided by your in-person class teachers.
- Seek help through the designated communication platform if needed.

### End of Day:

• Review your day's work to confirm completion and readiness for the following day.


